

**TOWNSHIP OF SEGUIN
MINUTES OF CEMETERY COMMITTEE MEETING
April 21st, 2009**

A regular meeting of the Township of Seguin Cemetery Committee was held on April 21, 2009 at the Township of Seguin Municipal Office. After the meeting was called to order the Chair requested approval of the agenda.

The Chair requested that any disclosures of pecuniary interest be declared. There were no disclosures of pecuniary interest.

The following Committee members were present: Bill Jameson, Marg Presley, Julia Fraser and Ed Forbes, Chair. Committee members, Everett Jacklin and Robert Bradley sent their regrets.

The Committee reviewed the March 17th, 2009 draft Cemetery Meeting minutes and there was additional information regarding the cost of obtaining a copy of a Will deposited at the Land Registry Office – the cost is \$25.00 plus copy charges of 50 cents per page if requested through a title searching company. Wills that are required for land transactions are available at the Land Registry Office, however not all Wills are located there. The Provincial Cemeteries Act requires that the owner of a cemetery obtain permission from the current Certificate Rights Holder before any burials are done or any monuments placed on a cemetery lot.

The Committee received a request from Gord Brown, Facilities Supervisor to meet with the Committee to inspect the four cemeteries that are licensed as active cemeteries. This inspection will take place on Monday, April 27th, 2009 commencing at 9:00 am at Christie Memorial Cemetery.

The Committee reviewed the revenue and expenditure sheets dated April 20th, 2009. There are currently thirteen burials booked and it appears that this will be a busy year for Seguin cemeteries.

Mr. Alec Clute of WeirFoulds LLP provided a final letter dated April 14, 2009 regarding the legal opinion requested from him last year. It appears that there is no clear response regarding whether or not a Reservation is still in effect after the death of the Certificate Rights Holder. Mr. Clute suggests that this is a matter for the courts to determine.
