

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SEGUIN

BY-LAW NUMBER 2024-015

BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE THE USE OF TOWNSHIP DOCKS AND BOAT LAUNCHES

WHEREAS Sections 8 and 10 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, the Township may pass by-laws regulating the use of public lands owned or under the control of the Township;

AND WHEREAS Section 9 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural Person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS Section 8. (1) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, the powers of a municipality under this or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS Section 23.1 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, authorizes a municipality to delegate its powers and duties to a person;

AND WHEREAS Section 123 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, states a local municipality may, for the purpose of public safety, regulate with respect to cliffs, pits, deep waters and other dangerous places;

AND WHEREAS access to docks and boat launches owned by the Township of Seguin, are intended to be available for use by the public at large, and Council deems it in the public interest to ensure access and use thereof is unimpeded;

AND WHEREAS it is desirable to regulate the use of Township Docks and Boat Launches to ensure safe usage;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SEGUIN HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. SHORT TITLE AND APPLICATION

- 1.1 This By-law may be cited as the "Township Dock and Boat Launch By-law".
- 1.2 This By-law applies to all Township Dock and Boat Launches.

2. DEFINITIONS

In this By-law, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

- 2.1 "Anchor" means to secure a Boat in a location upon the water;
- 2.2 Authorized Sign" means any sign, notice, or other device placed or erected by the Township;

- 2.3 "Boat" means any vessel which floats on the surface of the water and is capable of carrying people or material whether motorized or not and includes but is not limited to pleasure crafts, scows, personal watercrafts, rafts, canoes, row boats, pontoon boats, barges, float planes when on water or land;
- 2.4 "Boat Trailer" means any trailer designed, intended and/or capable of use for transporting a Boat;
- 2.5 "Council" means the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Seguin;
- 2.6 "Commercial Boat" means any Boat which is used for purposes other than personal use and includes any Boat used in the conduct of a business or commercial venture including but not limited to that which generates revenue by charging a fee for the transportation of goods, the transportation of people, the sale of goods from the Boat or any other service provided by or from the Boat;
- 2.7 "Director" means the Director of Community Services of the Township of Seguin, or their designate;
- 2.8 "Dock" means any structure used for the Mooring of Boats and includes a wharf, pier, or other similar structure;
- 2.9 "Emergency Vehicle or Boat" means a vehicle or Boat utilized by Emergency Service providers (ambulance, fire, police);
- 2.10 "Fish/Fishing" means to engage in or attempt to engage in the act of catching Fish;
- 2.11 "Launching Ramp" means an area set aside and improved for the purpose of the launching or recovery of boats to and/or from the water including such adjacent areas necessary for the manoeuvring of vehicles and Boat Trailers;
- 2.12 "Moor" means securing a Boat in any way to a Dock whether it is attended by Persons or not (and includes Mooring, Moored);
- 2.13 "*Municipal Act, 2001*" means the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended;
- 2.14 "Municipal Law Enforcement Officer" means a person appointed by Council for the Township for the enforcement of its by-laws;
- 2.15 "Officer" means any person authorized by the Township to enforce this By-law or to carry out inspections in relation to this By-law, and includes a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer or a Police Officer;

- 2.16 "Owner" means an individual or corporation who owns a Boat or the Person operating or having care and control of a Boat at any particular time;
- 2.17 "Person" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, firm, trust, or other entity and includes anyone acting on behalf or under the authority of such entity;
- 2.18 "Police Officer" means a member of the Ontario Provincial Police Force or means a person so appointed under the *Police Services Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P. 15 as amended;
- 2.19 "Township Dock and Boat Launch" means the whole of such parcels of land owned by and/or under the control of the Township including lands covered by water whereupon the Township maintains a Dock and/or Launching Ramp for public use and without limiting the foregoing includes any such parcels of land so designated by the Township as set out in Schedule "B";
- 2.20 "Township" means the Corporation of the Township of Seguin.

3. GENERAL PROHIBITIONS

- 3.1 No Person shall Moor a Boat at a Dock except as permitted by this By-law.
- 3.2 No Person shall Moor a Boat at a Dock between the hours of 11:00 pm and 6:00 am the following day, unless:
- (a) a permit authorizing such Mooring has been issued by the Township, or
 - (b) specifically permitted elsewhere in this By-law.
- 3.3 No Person shall Moor a Boat at a Dock for a continuous period in excess of one (1) hour, except:
- (a) at the "Rosseau Waterfront" located at 2 Jim Swift Drive in the Township of Seguin (legal description of which is PCL 1087 SEC SS; WATER LT IN FRONT OF LT 8 & 9 SHORT ST & ADJOINING WLY SIDE OF WATER ST IN THE VILLAGE OF ROSSEAU AS IN LP2548) in accordance with Section 3.2 of this By-law;
 - (b) unless a permit authorizing such Mooring has been issued by the Township; or
 - (c) unless specifically permitted elsewhere in this By-law.
- 3.4 No Person shall place any materials on a Dock for a continuous period in excess of twenty (20) minutes.

- 3.5 No Person shall place any materials on a Dock or upon or near a Launching Ramp at any time in a location which would prevent the use of the Dock or Launching Ramp by others.
- 3.6 No Person shall leave a Boat or materials on a Launching Ramp, except while in the course of launching or removing a Boat from the water.
- 3.7 No Person shall service or wash a Boat at a Township Dock and Boat Launch, except in the case of an emergency.
- 3.8 No Person shall leave a Boat on any beach at a Township Dock and Boat Launch, unless such activity is permitted as indicated by an Authorized Sign.
- 3.9 No Person shall Anchor a Boat at a Township Dock and Boat Launch or within such a distance from a Dock or Launching Ramp thereon that would impede or interfere with the use of such Dock or Launching Ramp.
- 3.10 No Person shall Moor, launch or recover a Boat at a Township Dock and Boat Launch other than from, upon or at the Dock and/or Launching Ramp located therein.

4. SIGNAGE AND EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT

- 4.1 No Person shall remove or deface any Authorized Signs.
- 4.2 No Person shall disobey an Authorized Sign at a Township Dock and Boat Launch.
- 4.3 No Person shall interfere with or misuse any lifesaving, fire prevention or other emergency equipment at a Township Dock and Boat Launch.

5. COMMERCIAL BOATS

- 5.1 No Person shall Moor, launch or recover a Commercial Boat at a Township Dock and Boat Launch without a permit, issued under Section 6 of this By-law.
- 5.2 Where authorized under a permit issued under Section 6, no Person shall Moor a Commercial Boat at a Dock except in accordance with the terms and conditions as set out in the permit.
- 5.3 No Person shall Moor, launch or recover a Commercial Boat at a Township Dock and Boat Launch set out in Schedule "C".

6. PERMITS

- 6.1 The Director, or their designate, may issue a permit authorizing an exemption from a provision or provisions under this By-law or a Person to Moor, launch and/or recover a Commercial Boat at a Township Dock and Boat Launches listed in

Schedule "B" of this By-law and may assign conditions or terms as deemed appropriate and in accordance with the fees set out in Schedule "A" of this By-law. If said conditions or terms are not adhered to the permit may be revoked. Any permit granted shall specify the time period of a duration during which it is effective.

6.2 Every Person issued a permit shall ensure the associated Boat or Commercial Boat is Moored in accordance with the terms and conditions of its permit and shall display that permit in a visible location.

7. EXEMPTIONS

7.1 This By-law shall not apply to:

- (a) Emergency Service providers (ambulance, police and fire services) while such providers are acting within the scope of their duties and in the course of providing emergency services or enforcement;
- (b) The Township, its employees or agents acting within the scope of their duties as employees or agents of the Township.

8. ENFORCEMENT AND INSPECTION

8.1 The provisions of this By-law may be enforced by an Officer.

8.2 No Person shall hinder or obstruct, or attempt to hinder or obstruct, any Officer exercising a power or performing a duty under this By-law. Any Person who is alleged to have contravened any of the provisions of this By-law shall identify themselves to the Officer upon request, failure to do so shall be deemed to have obstructed or hindered the Officer in the execution of his duties.

8.3 The Owner of a Boat, or the Person operating or having care and control of a Boat, is responsible for compliance with the provisions of this By-law.

8.4 In addition to any other penalties provided for in this By-law, where an Officer determines that:

- (a) there exists a contravention of this By-law; or
- (b) the Mooring of a Boat constitutes a hazard to the public; or
- (c) where a Boat has been abandoned, whether the Owner or operator of the Boat can be identified or not,

an Officer may, without notice, have the Boat removed, taken away and stored at a suitable place at the Owner's expense. The Township shall not be

responsible for any damage that may be sustained by the property of the Owner.

- 8.5 All costs and charges incurred for removing, taking away and storing a Boat pursuant to Section 8.4 of this By-law, shall be a lien upon the Boat, which lien may be enforced in the manner prescribed by the *Repair and Storage Liens Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter R.25*, as amended.
- 8.6 The Owner of a Boat or material which is relocated or removed, the Township may recover its costs of remedying the violation of this By-law by applying all fees included in accordance with the fees set out in Schedule "A" by invoicing the Owner or by adding the cost to the tax roll in the same manner as municipal taxes. The exercise of any such remedy shall not preclude the exercise of any other available remedy.

9. PENALTIES

- 9.1 Every Person who contravenes any provision of this By-law is guilty of an offence and is liable to a fine as provided for in the *Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.33*, as amended (the "Provincial Offences Act").
- 9.2 Every Person who contravenes any provision of this By-law, or orders made under this By-law, or every director or officer of a corporation who knowingly concurs in the contravention by a corporation is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine of:
- (a) Not more than \$10,000.00 for a first offence; and
 - (b) Not more than \$25,000.00 for a second or subsequent offence.
- 9.3 In the case of a continuing offence, for each day or part of a day that the offence continues, a maximum fine of \$10,000.00. The total of all of the daily fines for the offence is not limited to \$100,000.00;
- 9.4 If a Person is convicted of an offence under this By-law, in addition to any other remedy or any penalty imposed, the court in which the conviction has been entered, and any court of competent jurisdiction, may make an order:
- (a) prohibiting the continuation or repetition of the offence by the Person convicted; and
 - (b) requiring the Person convicted to correct the contravention in the manner and within the period that the court considers appropriate.
- 9.5 In addition to the foregoing penalties, any Boat Moored at a Dock or otherwise placed in contravention of this By-law may be restrained and immobilized at the

direction of an Officer or their designate until such time as the Owner identifies themselves with photo identification and a Boat Operator's Licence. Any costs and expenses incurred for restraining and immobilizing are the responsibility of the Boat Owner and are subject to such fees as set out in Schedule "A".

10. INTERPRETATION

10.1 Wherever a word is used in this By-law with its first letter capitalized, the term is being used as it is defined in Section 2 of this By-law. Where any word appears in ordinary case, the commonly applied English language meaning is intended.

10.2 Wherever a word defined in Section 2 of this By-law is used in the form of a noun, verb, adverb, or adjective, it shall be interpreted as having a corresponding defined meaning even if it is in ordinary case.

10.3 All words importing the singular shall include the plural, and words importing the masculine gender shall include the feminine, and the converse of the foregoing also applies, unless the context of the By-law requires otherwise.

11. SEVERABILITY

11.1 Should any section, clause or provision of this By-law be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the By-law as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part which was declared to be invalid.

12. ENACTMENT

12.1 This By-law shall come into full force and effect on the date that it is passed.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED AND ENACTED this 13th day of May, 2024.
