

Retailer Responsibilities: Selling Fireworks in Seguin Township

Understanding Fireworks By-Law #2023-106

Seguin Township appreciates cooperation and support from local businesses working with us to protect the safety and wellbeing of our community and natural environment.

Key Reminders for Retailers

- Fireworks can not be sold to any person under 18 years of age
- Batches of displayed fireworks can not exceed 25 kgs and must be in sealed packages away from inflammable materials
- Fireworks cannot be sold from an outdoor stand, tent, enclosed trailer, or motor vehicle
- The sale of firecrackers is prohibited
- Consumers are limited to setting off fireworks on designated holidays only.
- By-law officers will conduct random inspections to ensure compliance.

Sell fireworks from outdoor stand/tent/unenclosed trailer/motor vehicle	\$300.00	\$60.00 + \$5.00	\$365.00
Sell firecrackers or prohibited fireworks	\$300.00	\$60.00 + \$5.00	\$365.00
Hinder or obstruct or attempt to hinder or obstruct by-law officer	\$500.00	\$110.00 + \$5.00	\$615.00
Fail to comply with notice or order	\$500.00	\$110.00 + \$5.00	\$615.00

Consumer fireworks are permitted only on these days:

Consumer fireworks are permitted only on these days:
