On May 21st, 2019, Seguin Township Council together with Senior Township Staff will meet to review the current Strategic Plan. The current Strategic Plan identifies three specific areas of focus for Council including:

- protecting the (natural, visual and social) environment;
- promoting economic vitality; and
- delivering products and services in an efficient and effective manner

The current plan defines specific goals as well as objectives or tasks to be accomplished. Our new Strategic Plan will set an agreed upon path for the work that we will do together. It needs to be relevant and reflective of current community priorities and interests, and it should articulate a set of agreed-upon Council priorities for action. Our new Strategic Plan will act as our roadmap for this term of Council, but it will also serve as an important billboard for us to communicate to others why Seguin Township is so truly remarkable.
