



## **The Compactors Are Here!!**

We are pleased to introduce all Seguin Residents to our new recycling compactors. The transfer sites at Brooks Road, Turtle Lake Road, Christie and Humphrey have been equipped with new compacting recycling bins to ensure efficient transfer of our recycled material. This will allow for significantly more material to be loaded into the bins prior to being shipped out, which will result in lower operating costs. These bins are animal proof and will help to keep the sites cleaner overall and protect the safety of all residents. Our current recycling contractor will now handle all of our recycling in fewer trips, which will improve our carbon footprint.

This project has been funded by the CIF fund of Stewardship Ontario and Township of Seguin.

To further increase our efficiencies, Airport, Stanley House and Bon Echo have been equipped with 40yard large recycling bins to accommodate the demand of our very successful blue box recycling program. The balance of the gray containers on all sites have been switched to Household waste which increases the waste capacity. Our trucks will only pick up household waste at these sites now. This will save the Township money.
