Message to the residents of Seguin Township,

We are all dealing with an unprecedented public health emergency. The Township's priority is to keep our employees and our residents safe and healthy while continuing to provide essential services.

Seguin continues to follow the advice of the North Bay Parry Sound District Health Unit, the West Parry Sound Health Centre and the Province. The advice is to stay home, except for essential reasons. The West Parry Sound Emergency Command Group meets three times a week and we are closely monitoring COVID-19 cases, resolved and presumed.

All citizens of Seguin, whether they own primary or secondary residences, are expected to follow all of the public health directives including self-isolation. If you are arriving from outside the country, or have been in close contact with anyone with a presumptive case of Covid-19, you must self-isolate for a minimum of 14 days. Physical distancing is paramount to preventing the spread of the virus and we are all urged to stay in our homes, except for essential reasons. Avoid non-essential travel and ensure that only one member of your family visits shops for essential needs.

If you are residing in Seguin, please support your local businesses. Many have new websites and are offering telephone and online ordering. Many of these local businesses have increased their inventory to help support all of us during the COVID-19 outbreak. Many will prepare your order for curbside pickup. They deserve our support.

If you cannot or should not be outside of your home, groceries and pharmaceuticals can be delivered. A list of social services, deliveries and local businesses offering help can be found at [seguin.ca](http://seguin.ca).

Please be aware that the Province has implemented a Restricted Fire Zone in our region until further notice. This means no burning at any time of day including campfires. By provincial order, Seguin's marinas, boat launches and campgrounds are closed until further notice.

All residents of Seguin Township deserve our respect and support as they follow the Public Health advice. Together we will survive and thrive.
