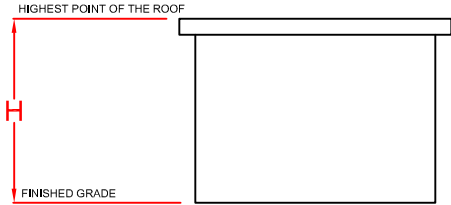

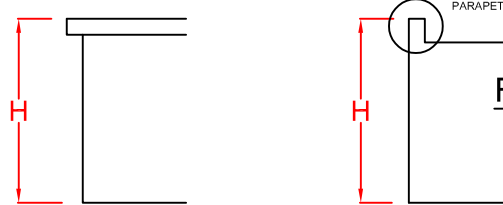


SIDE VIEW

SHED ROOF

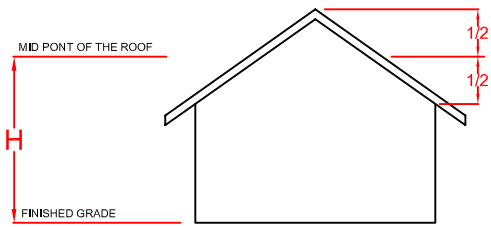

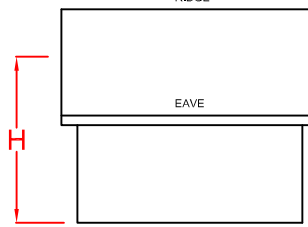

FLAT ROOF

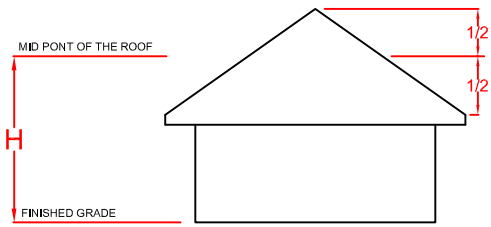

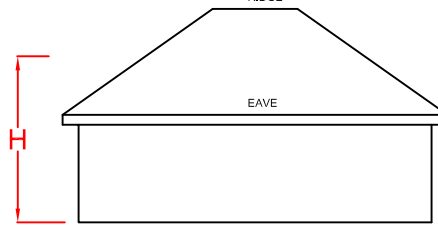

GABLE ROOF

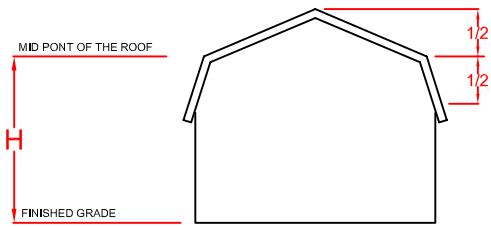

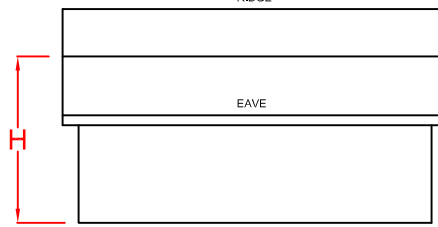

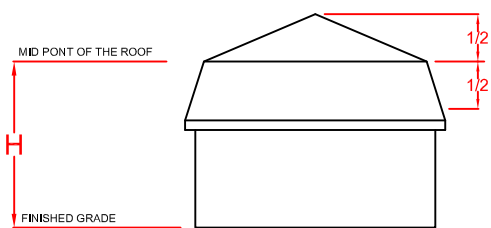

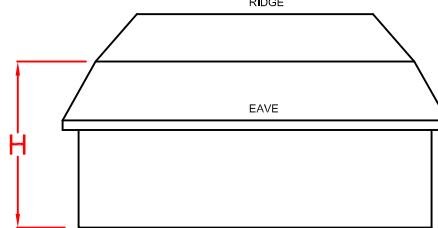

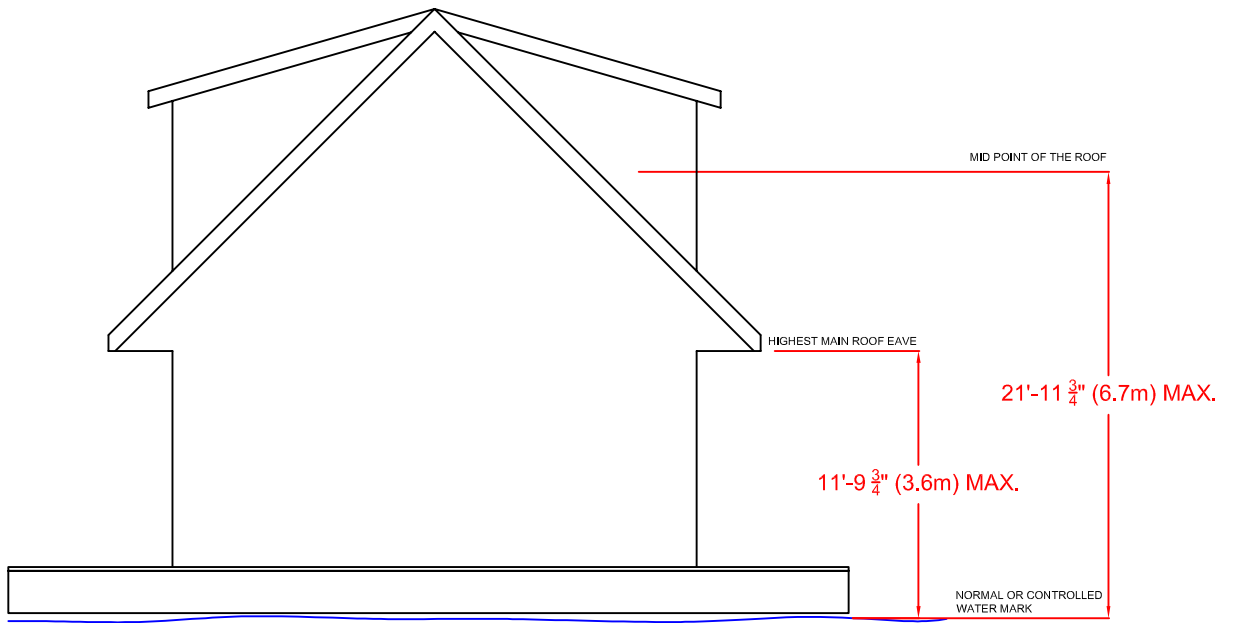

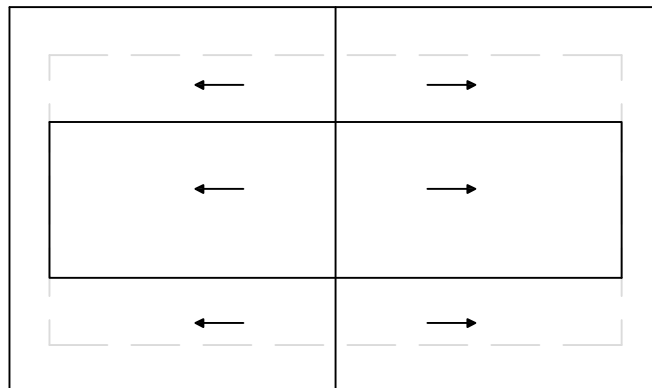
1 STOREY BOATHOUSE

DORMER:
TYPE OF DORMERS ARE, HIPPED, SHED, EYEBROW AND GABLE.
WHERE A DORMER MAKE UP MORE THAN 50% OF THE ROOF PLANE,
THEY SHALL BE CONSIDERED THE MAIN ROOF. A RECESSED DORMER
SHALL NOT BE PERMITTED ON A BOATHOUSE

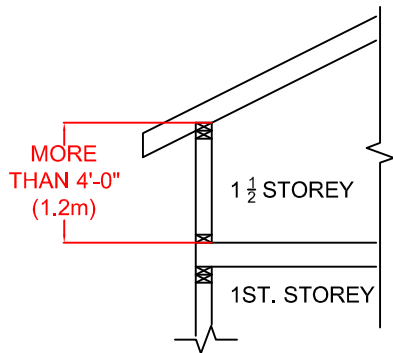
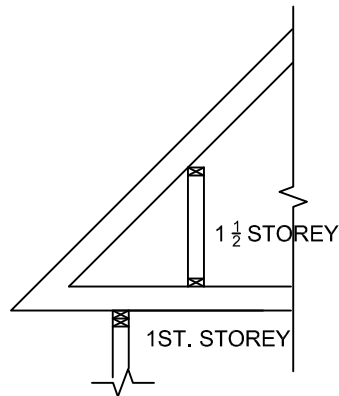
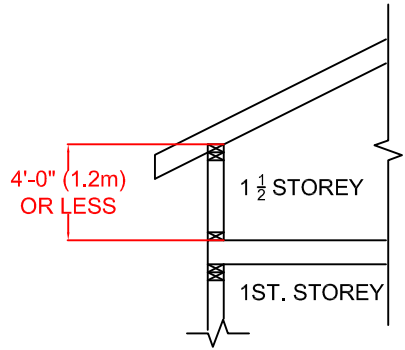

ILLUSTRATIONS OF DEFINITIONS:

STOREY, HALF

MEANS THE PORTION OF A BUILDING SITUATED WITHIN THE ROOF OR HAVING ITS FLOOR LEVEL NOT LOWER THAN 4'-0" (1.2m) BELOW THE LINE WHERE THE ROOF/ DORMER AND EXTERIOR ENCLOSING WALLS MEET; AND WHEN USED WITH REFERENCE TO A ONE AND A HALF STOREY BOATHOUSE, MEANS THAT PORTION OF THE BOATHOUSE SITUATED BETWEEN A SLOPING ROOF AND A FLOOR ABOVE THE FIRST STOREY BELOW, OF A BOATHOUSE.
