

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SEGUIN

BY-LAW NO. 2021-016

Being a By-law to Designate Reduced Load Periods on certain Municipal Highways or Portions thereof within the Township of Seguin and to Repeal By-law No. 2018-108 and all other By-laws and Resolutions, or parts thereof, contrary hereto or inconsistent herewith.

WHEREAS the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.8, as amended, Section 122 Reduced load periods, allows for the regulating of loads on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.8, as amended, Section 122 (7) states, "The municipality or other authority having jurisdiction over a highway may by by-law designate the date on which a reduced load period shall start or end and the highway or portion thereof under its jurisdiction to which the designation applies. R.S.O. 1990, c. H.8, s. 122 (7);

AND WHEREAS reduced load periods are deemed necessary for the protection of certain highways in the Township of Seguin;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Seguin hereby enacts as follows:


1. **THAT** in this By-law "reduced load period" means a reduced load period within the meaning of Section 122 of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.8, as amended.
2. **THAT** in this By-law "highway" means a highway within the meaning of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.8, as amended.
3. **THAT** all highways within the Township of Seguin over which The Corporation of the Township of Seguin has jurisdiction are hereby designated as being subject to reduced load periods save and except the highways, or parts thereof, specified in Schedule "A" attached hereto.
4. **THAT** the reduced load period shall be in effect commencing upon the date upon which signs stating "Regulated Limits In Effect" are

displayed on such highway and ending upon the date upon which the foregoing signs are no longer on display.


5. **THAT** the Director of Public Works or designate for The Corporation of the Township of Seguin shall be and is hereby authorized to establish reduced load periods as necessary to protect the highway infrastructure. Determining criteria for the reduced load period or periods as the conditions warrant, shall include but not be limited to the adequacy of the road base to withstand fully loaded vehicles, the adequacy and safety of the road surface to withstand fully loaded vehicles and the prevailing and forecast climatic conditions.
6. **THAT** the Director of Public Works or designate for The Corporation of the Township of Seguin shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to obtain, install and maintain such signs as may be necessary to give effect to this By-law and to provide general notice to the public, through various means including the Township website, of the dates upon which reduced loads are anticipated to be put into effect and lifted.
7. **THAT** this By-law shall come into full force and effect upon final passage thereof.
8. **THAT** By-law No. 2018-108 is hereby repealed and that all By-laws and Resolutions or parts thereof of The Corporation of the Township of Seguin and the former Corporations of the Townships of Christie, Foley and Humphrey and the Village of Rosseau relating to the regulation of reduced load periods for Township highways are hereby repealed.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, PASSED and ENACTED this 1st day of March, 2021.

The following roads and road sections shall be exempt
from Reduced Loading By-law No. 2021-016.
