Seguin Township is seeking a volunteer to serve as Seguin's representative on the West Parry Sound Veterinary Service Committee.

The Northern Producer Animal Health Network (NPAHN) contributes to the development and maintenance of a viable and diverse livestock industry in northern Ontario through the provision of veterinary services to large animal owners and support activities including veterinary recruitment and retention, producer education, and communication. NPAHN has created 20 local committees in their designated communities that represent the large animal owners – the users of the Veterinary Assistance Program. These committees are called Veterinary Service Committees (VSC's) - they represent all large animal owners in their designated areas, advise NPAHN of local large animal health care issues, make suggestions for program improvements, name the contract vet(s) yearly that they want to provide health care services under the Veterinary Assistance Program and seek replacement veterinarians as the need arises. The Township of Seguin is represented by the West Parry Sound Veterinary Service Committee. The Committee generally meets once a year in the Fall.
